FISH STOCKING

This October NLMD will be releasing, with your help, 2000 crappie, 2000 perch and 3500 walleyes into the Lake. This program helps us maintain a healthy lake balance by sustaining strong game fish populations over the common carp that are abundantly present in North Lake. Common carp are part of North Lake's water quality issues as they disturb sediment and can uproot vegetation from the lake bottom. Stocking today not only provides years of fishing enjoyment but also contributes to the health of the lake.

The fish will be stocked from the Froebel launch on the Little Lake so there are no conflicts with the dredging project.

AQUATIC PLANTS –EEL GRASS/WILD CELERY (SEE PICTURE BELOW)

Starting in later August and well into September, the Eel Grass up-roots itself and floats all over the Lake dropping its seed pods. This is not an aquatic plant that DNR lets us treat chemically. It is a native plant and good for fish habitat, but it is a nuisance on North Lake.

Frequently, the Aquatic Plant Harvester/Skimmer gets blamed for spreading this plant. Obviously, some of that occurs, but the vast majority of spreading is due to nature.
